

CITY OF SEGUIN

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEGUIN, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 98-105 OF THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES AND PROVIDING FOR REVISIONS TO THE TWO-HOUR TIME LIMIT IN THE 200 BLOCK OF N. CAMP STREET; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION, A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO SUBMIT THIS ORDINANCE AS A SUPPLEMENT TO THE SEGUIN CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, Section 98-105 of the Seguin Code of Ordinances establishes the two-hour time limits for parking in certain areas of downtown Seguin, and

WHEREAS, the City of Seguin supports the Seguin Area Chamber of Commerce for locating their new offices that house the Convention & Visitor’s Bureau in downtown Seguin; and

WHEREAS, the location of the Seguin Area Chamber of Commerce offices at W. Gonzales and N. Camp Streets will bring increased vehicular traffic to this area and that it will benefit neighboring businesses, and visitors and tourists to limit the parking in the 200-block of N. Camp Street on the east side of the street to two-hours; and

WHEREAS, this recommendation should improve the availability of on-street parking in the vicinity of the new Chamber offices.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, it is hereby ORDAINED by the Seguin City Council as follows:

1. That Section 98-105 of the Seguin Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to provide two-hour parking on the east side of the 200-block of N. Camp Street between Gonzales and Mountain Streets.
2. Violations of this Ordinance shall be punished in accordance with the penalty provisions of the City of Seguin Code of Ordinances.
3. In accordance with Section 3.10 of the Seguin City Charter, this Ordinance shall become effective upon ten (10) days following passage on second reading and shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation.
4. If any clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be unenforceable for any reason, such unenforceable clause or provision shall be severed from the remaining portion of the Ordinance, which shall continue to have full force and effect.
5. City staff is hereby authorized to submit this Ordinance as a supplement to the Seguin Code of Ordinances.
